Re: Regulation of Noise at Red Rocks Amphitheatre

Gentlemen:

The purpose of this letter is to request action with respect to noise regulation at Red Rocks Amphitheatre (“Red Rocks”), including implementation of the recommendations made in the report by Geiler and Associates, LLC, dated December 10, 2014 (the “Geiler Report”).

The Town has received and reviewed the Geiler Report, an additional copy of which is attached hereto for your benefit and that of the Jefferson County Board of County Commissioners. The report documents the levels of sound produced at Red Rocks during the 2014 concert season, along with the continuing and damaging impact of that noise on residents in the area. While not comprehensive, the report certainly establishes the size and nature of the problem that the City of Denver is obligated to address.

It is important that Denver recognize the need to work with the Town and Jefferson County to create a long term solution to this issue now, before the next concert season. Not to do so will leave the Town in the position of considering other enforcement options. However, the Town would rather see if implementation of the Geiler report’s recommendations will make a significant difference.


The Morrison Board of Trustees believes the recommendations in the Geiler Report are a good start, but by no means a comprehensive approach and solution to the excessive noise produced at Red Rocks. Nevertheless, the report provides a place to begin, and for that reason, the Board requests that Denver act immediately to implement the two sets of recommendations in the Geiler report:

- Recommendations Regarding 2015 Noise Regulations (pages 10-11, specifically including the Draft-B 2015 noise regulations)
- Recommendations Regarding 2015 Noise Monitoring and Community Survey (pages 11-13)

In your response to this letter please indicate your willingness to meet with the Jefferson County Board of County Commissioners to update them on implementation of the recommendations in the Geiler Report, and whether the County should consider incorporating elements of those regulations into the County's noise regulation applicable to Red Rocks.

We look forward to your early response.
